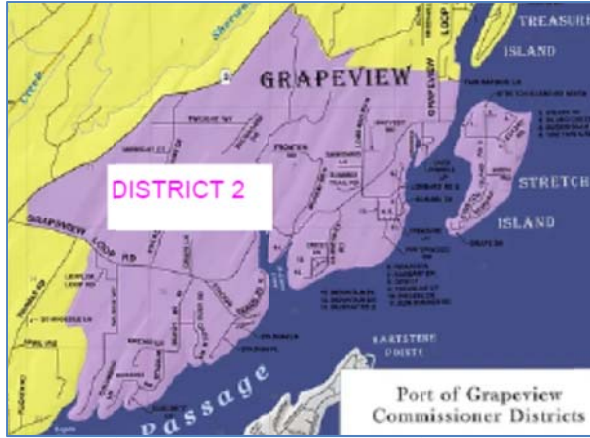


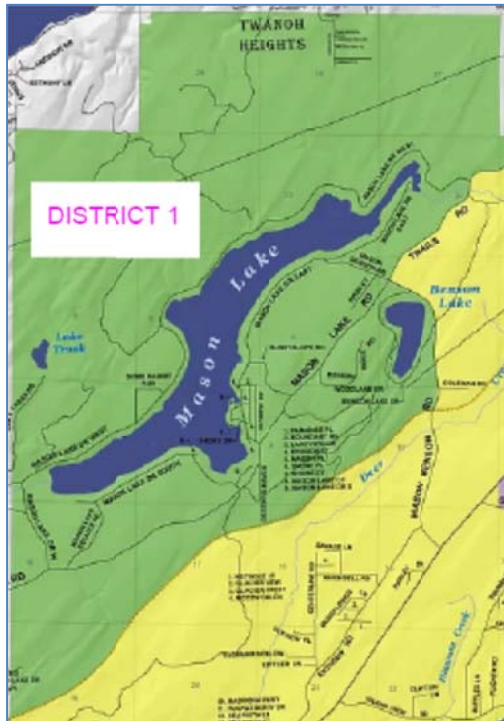
## PORT OF GRAPEVIEW COMMISSION VACANCIES

District 2 Port Commissioner Glenn Carlson, whose term expires December 2023, is resigning his seat early and the Port must appoint someone to fill the seat for the remainder of his term.



Interested parties must reside and be a registered voter in the area marked in purple.

No one filed to run for the District 1 seat this past November election, currently held by Jim Madden, whose term expires December 2021. The Commission must also appoint someone to fill that seat.



Interested parties must reside and be a registered voter in the area marked in green.

Applications are being accepted to fill both vacant seats. Interested applicants must live within the district for which they are applying and submit a letter of intent as well as a statement of qualifications by 31<sup>st</sup> day, Dec. 2021.

Current Port Commission members will interview applicants and then vote on potential District 1 and District 2 candidates at the January 18th, 2022 Commission meeting.

The newly selected Commissioner for District 2 will serve the remaining two years of Carlson's unexpired 6-year term. The newly selected Commissioner for District 1 will serve the full 6-year term.
