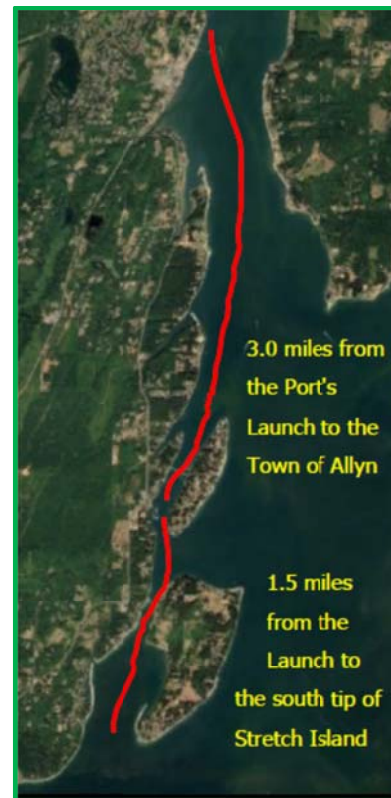
The area is perfectly situated for paddle sport activity. The launch and water trails are protected by both Treasure Island and Stretch Island which acts as a breakwater from wind and surf.

LAUNCH RAMP TO THE TOWN OF ALLYN 3.0 miles

Fair Harbor Marina is a private enterprise and has a store at the fuel dock.

Allyn has many restaurants, all within walking distance of the Port of Allyn launch ramp:

- 2 Margaritas - Mexican (In Allyn Market Plaza).
- Big Bubbas Burgers (Fast Food, outdoor dining only).
- Boat House Bar and Restaurant
- Allyn Ice Cream Parlor & Kayak Rentals
- Allyn Market Plaza (ATM, Food Store, Allyn Pizza))
- Espresso Coffee Kiosk
- Tourist: George Kenny's chain saw carvings.

Tying up: The Port of Allyn also has a ramp and launch. **Caution: At tides lower than PLUS 2.0 the area is a mud flat. Do not visit on an outgoing tide.**

LAUNCH RAMP TO THE STRETCH ISLAND CHANNEL & STATE PARK 1.5 miles

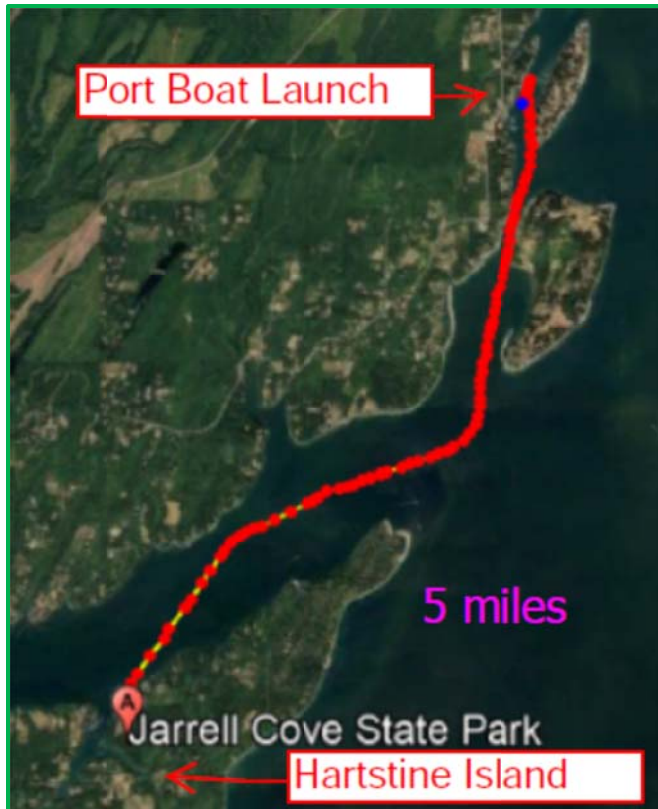
This is a fun trip with many coves to access, especially with children who you can surprise with tales of pirates!

Stretch Island State Park is accessible by water only. Respect shoreline residents - no clamming or oyster picking outside of the Park.

Caution: At tides lower than PLUS 2.0 the area south of the Stretch Island Bridge is a mud flat. Do not visit on an outgoing tide less than a 2.0 tide.

LAUNCH RAMP TO JARRELL COVE STATE PARK



Enclosed by Puget Sound and surrounded by Case Inlet and Pickering Passage, this park on Hartstine Island is a watery haven with excellent opportunities for swimming, diving and boating. An amphitheater, sports fields and camping make for entertainment and activities on terra firma. The sound of a boat chugging up to a buoy, the smell of a campfire and the sight of kids playing volleyball create a patchwork of humans in harmony with nature.

Jarrell's Cove Marina is located on Pickering Passage in South Puget Sound in Mason County. Jarrell's Cove Marina is just across the cove from Jarrell Cove State Park.
