TURNAROUND PROJECT UPDATE

The turnaround area is almost completed. It will be open for use very soon.

Kayak and other paddle sport users can now unload/load at the turnaround and walk their craft behind the restroom down to the beach without interfering with motorized boaters on the ramp.

Turnaround and Launch lanes are clearly marked. Please stay in your lane at the turnaround and at the launch ramp.

Parking stalls for **LOADING & UNLOADING** are available for short term parking. Signage will be installed to indicate for how long.

The restroom will not be available until next year when it is completed. The exterior is finished but the interior needs Mason County inspections, all the fixtures, etc.



2021 RAMP FEES

At its December meeting the Port Commissioners slightly raised use rates:

Commercial Annual Pass Fee (includes parking and restroom use) - \$115

Regular Annual Pass Fee (includes parking and restroom use) - \$85

Motorized Boat Launch Fee - \$7

Kayak & Paddle Sport Fee - \$2

Parking Fee \$5

These fees will be entered into the pay terminal later this month.
